



Tips for Users

Tips for proper use of the Ralston colour dispenser

- * Never fill the canisters above the upper blade of the stirrer. Do not fill the canisters if not necessary.
- * Fill the canisters of slow movers minimally.
- * Remove colorant from the canister rims and lids to ensure good closure of the canisters.
- * Shake colorants before re-filling the canisters.
- * The right volume of actually refilled colorant must be entered into the software. This will prevent the machine from dosing from empty canisters.
- * If the dispenser is not often used, all canisters should be purged once or twice a week. This will prevent colorant from drying in the nozzle which may cause slant-wise dosing.
- * Check during purging if each colorant is dosed in a straight line. If the colorant comes out slant-wise, the dispense opening must be cleaned manually.
- * Regularly check the contents of the canister. Check whether the actual contents level equals the contents level indicated in the software. Also check the condition of the colorants.
- * Regularly check the functioning of the stirring elements.
- * Regularly back up your own formula book.

Only for dispensers with brush container

- * The fluid level in the brush container should be checked daily. If necessary, fill up with brush cleaner to avoid dry turning.
- * Empty the brush container once a week and clean it carefully.
- * Weekly check the brush for proper functioning.

Only for Corob colour dispensers

- * Daily check the sponge in the nozzle-cap and wet the sponge with water. The sponge may not start floating.
- * Regularly replace the sponge. At least when it is saturated with colorant.
